# Timber Flooring Facts and Variation

**Wonderwood Timber Flooring is made from natural materials and differs in colour, texture and naturally occurring features both within and between individual pieces and batches of the same species. Samples, reproductions in printing, and photography are only for guidance; they provide a colour indication but are not necessarily representative of the overall effect or design.**

Please be cautious when making your selection based on a single sample, reproductions in printing and photography, as these are only indications. Timber flooring products will vary from board to board, job to job, and from the samples on display in all jobs supplied. The colour of your flooring may change over time due to exposure to UV light and oxygen. Minor splits and wood checks/cracks are naturally occurring in timber. Timber flooring products continue to absorb and release moisture, expand and contract over their lifetime depending on local conditions, environmental conditions, and weather changes.

Even with proper installation, slight expansion and contraction, as well as board separation, is normal; however, excessive movement due to extreme weather conditions can be expected. It is critical to be aware of and to check conditions to ensure that your floor performs within tolerances. Installing your timber floor according to Wonderwood Floors installation guideline is crucial for a high-performing floor.

Hardness is measured using the Janka scale (in kN). A higher number indicates a denser timber, making it significantly more resistant to denting, impacts, and heavy wear from pets, furniture, or foot traffic.

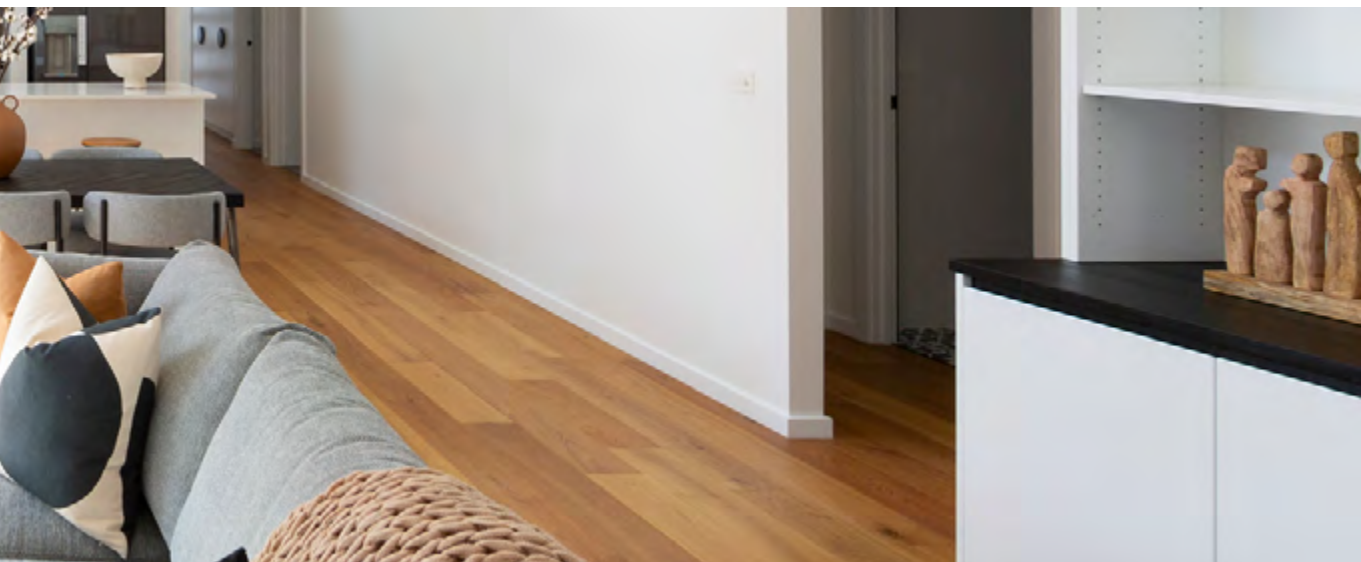

## Select Grade

Select Grade strikes the perfect balance between the refined appearance of Prime Grade and the character-filled look of Natural Grade.

You can expect small-to-medium knots, fine gum veins, and occasional checks. Sapwood and colour variation will be more noticeable than in Prime Grade, adding warmth and character without overpowering the floor’s overall elegance.

Select Grade is perfect for customers who appreciate some natural features for personality, while still maintaining a sophisticated, polished look.

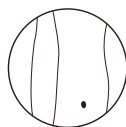
## Natural Grade

Natural Grade celebrates the beauty and individuality of timber in its most expressive form.

This grade includes a wide range of natural features—knots in various sizes, visible sapwood, checks, and cracks. Industrial filler may be used to enhance stability in areas with broken knots or larger checks. You may also see gum veins, insect trails, and noticeable colour variation, both between boards and within the same batch.

Natural Grade offers a truly one-of-a-kind appearance, with each board showcasing its own unique patterns from nature.

## Installation Guidelines

Wonderwood Timber Flooring is designed to be installed by secret nailed, direct stick (trowel glue down), or as a floated floor. Please inspect each board in optimal lighting for visual defects, and ensure the locking system is functioning properly before and during installation. Products are considered to be of acceptable quality and structure once installed; do not install them if in doubt. Please note that only direct adhesive fixing system is suitable for Herringbone or Chevron parquetry installation. Heavy and bulky objects, such as island bench, should not be placed on floating floors, Wonderwood Timber Flooring must be cut in and installed around such objects. 8% to 10% of wastage floors is recommended to cover any sorting, trimming or visual selection during installation. 20% of wastage floors is expected for Herringbone or Chevron parquetry.

## Timber Flooring Moisture Content

Before installation, a moisture meter must be equipped to ensure the moisture content of Wonderwood Timber Flooring remains in about 8%-12% on average, as timber floor is a natural product, a significant change of moisture content may result in product distortion.
